

CONTRACT FOR MUSIC AT WEDDING SERVICE

SUMMARY:

This is a contract binding all parties to an agreement which affirms that Kainoa Fukumoto will provide the agreed musical services in regards to the wedding service of:

Kainoa Fukumoto is the provider of the piano and vocal music performance, and the originator of this contract, and is also referred to as “Kainoa.” The wedding ceremony may also be referred to as the “event” or “service” in this contract. The contact listed on this contract—who may be the groom, bride, wedding coordinator, or other person—is the “liable party” on this contract.

RATES AND FEES:

Rate set for this event: **\$250.00**

The above rate includes:

- Music performance, as agreed, during the ceremony (this covers typical ceremonies between 30-60 minutes)

Other applicable fees:

- \$50 / 30 minutes = additional rehearsal time with other performers (i.e. singers, instrumentalists, etc.)*
- \$30 / 15 minutes = event is delayed from the start time
- \$10 / 15 minutes = event is overtime following an hour after the beginning of the service
- If no piano is available or the piano condition is not adequate, there is a \$25 convenience fee for Kainoa to provide a portal keyboard for the event.

**Additional rehearsal times must be arranged with Kainoa at least 15 days prior to the event date.*

DEPOSIT AND CANCELLATION POLICY:

A deposit of \$75 or 25% of the estimated charges, whichever is greater, is required no later than 15 days prior to the event date. Failure to meet the deposit payment by the due date may result in termination of services.

Deposits will be refunded, less a \$10 service charge, if a cancellation notice is received no later than 8 days prior to the event. Notices must be given via email or written notice.

If a notice is received within 2-7 days prior to the event, the deposit will not be refunded, however, no additional charges will be liable against the groom and bride. The groom and bride will, however, be liable for the entire cost relating to rehearsal times that were actually met prior to the cancellation notice.

If a notice is received less than 48 hours prior to the event, all applicable charges will be due. If the event is cancelled and no notice is received, all charges will be due in addition to a \$150 cancellation fee.

PAYMENT:

An invoice will be sent to the email address provided below. The remaining balance (less the deposit) of the total charges is due on the date of the event. Acceptable forms of payment include checks payable to "Kainoa Fukumoto", cash, or online payment by credit card through the emailed invoice.

If additional charges accrue on the day of the event, an invoice detailing the additional charges will be sent to the liable party within 3-5 days following the event. Any remaining balance must be paid within 30 days following the event date.

If a payment in full is not received within 30 days, a \$25 late fee will be added to the account. Delinquent balances can and may be referred to any collection and/or legal agencies if necessary. The liable party will be responsible for all costs relating to any collection and legal action ensued.
